

Homemade Baby Wipes How-To

Be gentle to your baby's bottom, all while saving money and trips to the store!

Ingredients:

- * 2 containers
- * 1 roll of Bounty Select-a-Size Paper Towels
- * 4 cups of prepared wipes solution (see below)

How-To:

Clean your containers and working surface. Using a large, sharp, non-serrated knife, carefully cut paper towel roll in half. Brush off any fuzzies or loose bits! Pour 2 cups of wipes solution into each container. Place paper towels, fuzzy side down, into solution filled container. Put lid on top, smooch as needed, make sure you have a tight seal, and flip container upside down. Let sit and soak for no less than 5 minutes.

Remove paper towel roll from center (best while wet!). Grab the start of the paper in the center, pop it up for easy grabbing, and close the lid. Enjoy your wipes and baby's smooth skin!

Lily's Wipe Solution:

4 cups Water, 2 T melted Coconut Oil, 1 Squirt Organic Baby Wash.

Measure 4 cups water in large measuring bowl (to avoid spills). Heat oil and some of the water over low heat, just until melted. Mix in large measuring cup, swish and swirl till mixed, and add to containers! Coconut oil is naturally anti-bacterial and good for baby's skin – won't it dry out!

Tips and Other Uses:

- * When traveling, grab a handful and stick them into a Ziploc baggie - instant travel wipes!
- * Two containers will last you between one and two weeks.
- * Experiment with a mixture that works for you... adding essential oils, omitting baby wash, using just water, the possibilities are endless! Just remember, 4 cups of water is best.
- * With the coconut oil, they make GREAT make-up remover wipes or moisturizing wipes for mommy or baby!
- * This process could easily be used to make cleaning wipes ! Using a diluted organic cleaner, it's just as simple four cups of water plus a few drops of the concentrated solution.
